MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 23RD MEETING: Kevin made a motion to accept and approve the minutes of the January 23rd meeting. Christi 2nd the motion. Motion passed with a voice vote.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: Sara let the board know that she was approached about the BMX track and possibly putting in a pump track. There was discussion as to what may happen to the existing BMX track if the pool gets remodeled.

NATHAN LINDQUIST-INSPIRE INITIATIVE: Nathan let the board know about the natural play area at Centennial Park and showed some examples of what the play area would look like. He said they would be going for a grant in July to help with the costs. The towns up for these types of playgrounds are New Castle, Rifle and Parachute. He stated that this would be County funded and not funded by the City.

NATHAN LINDQUIST-TRAILS UPDATE: Nathan let the board know that they met with the Animal Shelter and the School District about the trail that will go along the new Animal Shelter property and Rifle High School. He stated that the Rifle Creek Trail is still in legal limbo. Christi suggested a portable toilet being placed at Morrow Drive trail.

VENDING IN PARKS UPDATE: Tom let the board know that the notice to vendors was posted to apply for vendor permits in the parks.

UPDATE ON FEES: Tom asked if the board had any comments on the meeting with Council about Little League and fees. Chris stated that there were three different directions going on at the meeting and not much was accomplished. Tom stated that Matt will meet with Council one on one to discuss Little League and fees. Tom will get back to the board when he hears more.

PROJECTS UPDATE: None

OTHER: Tom let the board know that a press release was sent out to inform the City about a test fireworks shoot taking place on Sunday the 12th of February. They are testing fireworks at a new location to see if it would be feasible for the 3rd of July show.
