The next question brought up was the signature events for the City. Tom suggested fewer events and making them a good event. Alan suggested that bands be changed for the Western Adventure weekend because people didn't attend those. Kim stated that the concert would be moving to the Ute. Kim asked for PRAB and staff to complete the survey and get it back to her.
